MSBA gives nod to proceed with Concord Carlisle High School schematic design

Concord — State Treasurer Steven Grossman, chairman of the **Massachusetts School Building Authority** (MSBA) and Katherine Craven, MSBA executive director, have announced that the MSBA Board of Directors voted to proceed into schematic design to replace the existing **Concord-Carlisle Regional High School** with a new high school on the existing site. The agreed-upon design will be for 1,225 students in grades nine through 12. The MSBA and Concord-Carlisle will continue to work in collaboration to produce detailed renderings to determine the precise scope and budget of the proposed project.

“This is a very exciting stage in the MSBA process,” said Grossman. “The schematic designs that will be produced will give us our first look at the improved Concord-Carlisle Regional High School. They will help us narrow the scope and budget of the project so that we can be sure the final product is efficient, sustainable and affordable.”

“We have worked diligently with Concord-Carlisle over the last several years and I look forward to continuing our work with them during this next stage in the process to replace the existing school with a new school that meets MSBA guidelines,” said Craven.

The MSBA strives to find the right-sized, most fiscally-responsible and educationally-appropriate solutions to create safe and sound learning environments. In its six-year history, the MSBA has made more than \$7.9 billion in reimbursements to cities, towns, and regional school districts for school construction projects. These timely payments have saved municipalities more than \$2.9 billion in avoided local interest costs and have provided much needed cash flow to communities in these difficult economic times.
