Call to Order

There are a lot of constituents besides MSBA; there are MA CHPS, energy efficiency, town authorities, town department/boards, towns of Concord and Carlisle, DEP, facilities department, and school building committee working towards a set of goals & values. The goals and values are going towards this \$75 million dollar construction project. The design team is here to try to create a holistic solution that embodies all of the ideals; it's a balance to make sure all of the needs are covered from all of the groups.

Maureen Kirkpatrick stated that once we get through design and development we will proceed with the early bid package which will be the earthwork package and superstructure package. It would start sometime mid to late October and the project would be complete by November 2015 which looks doable right now.

Michael Rosenfeld took us through the latest design development plan. We will get a lot more detail in another month.
